Course announcement "Advanced Microeconomics"

The Bavarian Graduate Program in Economics (BGPE) invites contributions to the next BGPE course **"Advanced Microeconomics"**. The course will take place in Pfaffenhofen an der Ilm from **September 15-19, 2025**, and will be taught by Zvika Neeman from the Eitan Berglas School of Economics, Tel Aviv University.

Preference will be given to Ph.D. students in Economics from the following Bavarian universities: Augsburg, Bamberg, Bayreuth, Eichstätt-Ingolstadt, Erlangen-Nürnberg, Passau, Regensburg, TU Munich, and Würzburg. The BGPE covers their course fee. The students are expected to take part in the final exam after the course on October 02, 2025.

Students from other, in particular non-Bavarian, Ph.D. programs or from the LMU Munich can participate if the course is not fully booked and if they pay a fee of 1,500 Euro per person in advance. The fee will cover the course itself and the option to take part in the exam.

After successful participation in the final exam, you will receive a BGPE course certificate.

The application deadline is **August 10, 2025**. For further information (incl. course description and application procedure) please check www.bgpe.de. Notices of acceptance are usually sent about 4 weeks before the course.
